Book

Author's last name, initials. (Year published). *Book title*. City: Publisher.
Sturrock, P. (1999). *The UFO enigma: A new review of the physical evidence*. New York: Warner Books.

Electronic Book

Author's last name, initials. (Year published). *Book title* [Electronic version]. City: Publisher.
Campbell, P. (2000). *Alien encounters* [Electronic version]. Brookfield, CT: Millbrook.

Encyclopedia Article

Author's last name, initials. (Year published). Title of article. In *Title of encyclopedia* (volume number, page numbers). City: Publisher.
Michin, D. (2001). Introduction of Exotic Species. In *Encyclopedia of ocean sciences* (Vol. 2, pp. 877-889). New York: Academic Press.

Magazine Article

Author's last name, initials. (Year, Month day published). Title of article. *Title of Journal*, volume number, page numbers.
Creswell, J. (2001). See this goop? It kills anthrax. *Fortune*, 144, 147-148.

Journal Article

Author's last name, initials. (Year published). Title of article. *Title of Journal*, volume number (issue number), page numbers.
Pimentel, D., Lach, L., & Zuniga, R. (2000). Environmental and economic costs of nonindigenous species in the United States. *BioScience*, 50(1), 53-65.

Newspaper Article

Author's last name, initials. (Year, Month day published). Title of article. *Newspaper title*, page numbers.

Buggs, S. (2001, December 18). Texas lawmaker to introduce bill to protect employee savings. *Houston Chronicle*, p.A1.

Article published only on Internet

Author's last name, initials. (Year published). Title of article. *Title of Journal, volume number*. Retrieved date, from URL

DeTrude, J.A. & Stanfield, V.S. (2000). Successful women leaders: Achieving resiliency through rituals and resources. *Advancing Women in Leadership*, 3. Retrieved February 4, 2002, from <http://www.advancingwomen.com/awl/awl.html>

Article from a Database

Author's last name, initials. (Year published). Title of article. *Title of Journal, volume number*, page numbers. Retrieved date, from Database name.

Jaroff, L. (2000). A winning combination. *Time Atlantic*, 156, 66-69. Retrieved December 20, 2001, from Academic Search Premier database.

Article also published in print

Author's last name, initials. (Year published). Title of article [Electronic version]. *Title of Journal, volume number*, page numbers.

Averhoff, F., Shapiro, C., Bell, B., Hyams, I., Burd, L., Deladisma, A., et al. (2001). Control of Hepatitis A through routine vaccination of children [Electronic version]. *JAMA*, 286, 2968-2973.

Website

Author's last name, initials. (Year published). *Title of page*. Retrieved date, from URL
University of Houston System. (1999, February 5). *Community Impact Report*. Retrieved (Ανακτήθηκε στις ...ημερομηνία...) December 19, 2001, from (από...url)
